DIFFERENT GOLF COURSE STYLES

The geographical wealth of the Southwest of France allows for a wide variety of different golf course styles, playable all year round thanks to the particularly mild climate. Both the ocean coastline and inland share some of the finest courses in France and Europe.

Play on the greens of the top golf course in continental Europe, Pau Golf Club. Built in 1856 by the Scots, the oldest golf course on the European continent is also the oldest in the world outside the British Isles. Its club house is more of a museum really. The Scots made no mistake when they chose this setting on the edge of the gave (the name given to the Pyrenees mountain stream) with the Pyrenees as a backdrop. Created in 1993 and enlarged since 2009, the golf course of La Jenny is probably the only place in the world where the sport is practised in a naturist setting. You can play with 6 real holes (4 par 3, 2 par 4) including a water hazard, a large putting green and a genuine driving range of 20 stands including 10 that are sheltered.
